We celebrate the opening of this new room May 31st 2007 in presence of Moty Brill, mayor of Arad, his team, the school's board, and overall, the students who were free to decorate the room as they felt. Opening this room helps to :

- Create a social club for the students of the only high school of Arad
- Avoid the students to find themselves in the streets of Arad between two classes
- Rest and discuss, study, this was missing in the school
- United the students. They were responsible and autonomous on this project
- Last but not least, the room is decorated with drawings and pictures done by the students themselves. Therefore, this space can also be considered as a show room.

After this visit to Arad, we started considering the next project to continue supporting this school. Among the numerous ideas given by Arad's Mayor, here are the projects we have chosen.

Projects to finance for 2007 :

1. Financing grants to allow high potential students from poor families to continue their studies.

It is important to specify that Arad is a little town, on the border of the Negev that has absorbed, in the last decade, large numbers of new immigrants from countries such as Ethiopia, the Ex-Soviet Union States, and Latin America. The children of these families have really high intellectual potential; however, they meet financial problems that usually prevent them to continue their studies. We want to help them by giving them the money they need. Let's dream and say that we are financing tomorrow's Nobel prizes!



2. Rehabilitation of the school's theater club

In 120W, we believe that art is an essential element of education. Theater is a mean of expression and a fundamental way to blossom. Moreover, it gives the 35 students, members of the club, the opportunity to play outside their own school. The club is livened up by a real theater fanatic. The club is located in the "Miklat" of the school (the shelter in case of bombing). The decor is really drab and old. We want to help them to get this place nicer in order to favor their work and creations.
